

**LETCHWORTH CSD SUMMER FOOD DISTRIBUTION PLAN**

Letchworth Central School District is participating in the NYS Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

- **All children 18 years of age or younger, or people (of all ages) with physical or mental disabilities who participate in special school programs for the disabled are eligible for this program.**
- Drive-thru and walk-up, **grab and go** food distribution will begin **Thursday, July 9** at the community locations as defined below.
- This service will be available on Mondays and Thursdays. On Mondays, three breakfasts and three lunches will be provided. On Thursdays, two breakfasts and two lunches will be provided.
- Parents may pick up meals for all children in the household.
- We will be using LCS **SUBURBANS** for transport and distribution.
- **In the event you are unable to make it to one of the distribution sites, home delivery will be available for children in the LCSD from approximately 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm. Please call (585) 493-3530 if you need home delivery.**
- Please contact the number listed above for dietary restrictions.
- Meals will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times as follows:
