Re: Instruction during quarantines

Dear Letchworth Parents,

The first month of school is drawing to a close. Overall, we are pleased with how things are progressing.

We are doing all we can to slow the spread of any positive COVID cases in school. The goal is to keep students safe and in school. If cases increase and quarantines become more frequent, more students will be out of school for days at a time under quarantine.

The school does not have a truly “remote option” for learning this year. Teachers will do all they can to keep your child progressing and communicate periodically about their work. **The school will use “Google Classroom” as the format to distribute instructional materials in grades K-12.** Some teachers may provide opportunities for your child to tune in to class or watch prepared videos of the classroom content. Teachers will have various ways to keep your child engaged in the learning while they are quarantined.

The key is to communicate with the teacher. Email and Google Classroom provide a platform to speak with your child’s teacher when they are quarantined.

This is not the same as last year. Last year we had a “remote learning” option for all students.

I hope this helps clarify this change in instruction when a student is out because of a quarantine.

Please contact your child’s teacher and/or principal if problems arise.
